

# EGG DROP RULES

1. Aircraft damaged during competition; void all points and disqualified.
2. If the competitor is not comfortable with the approach, they may go-around.
3. Competitors shall have three eggs for the three-scored hits.
4. Any egg outside of the box receives zero points.
5. The three-scored points awarded and then added together, make for the total points awarded and the high point total wins.
6. Aircraft must be on the extended centerline prior to crossing the runway end.
7. Aircraft must maintain at least 100 feet AGL. (960 feet MSL).
8. Aircraft cutting inside the runway end shall receive zero points for the egg that is dropped.
9. Airspeed during this competition is at the competitor's discretion.
10. Throttle shall be at the pilot's discretion throughout the egg drop.
11. If there is a discussion, regarding which box the egg landed; then, the next lower point box will be awarded.

- First box, 5 points
- Second box, 10 points
- Third box, 15 points
- Forth box, 20 points
- Fifth box, 25 points
- Sixth box, 30 points
- Seventh box, 35 points
- Eighth box, 40 points
- Ninth box, 45 points
- Tenth box, 50 points
