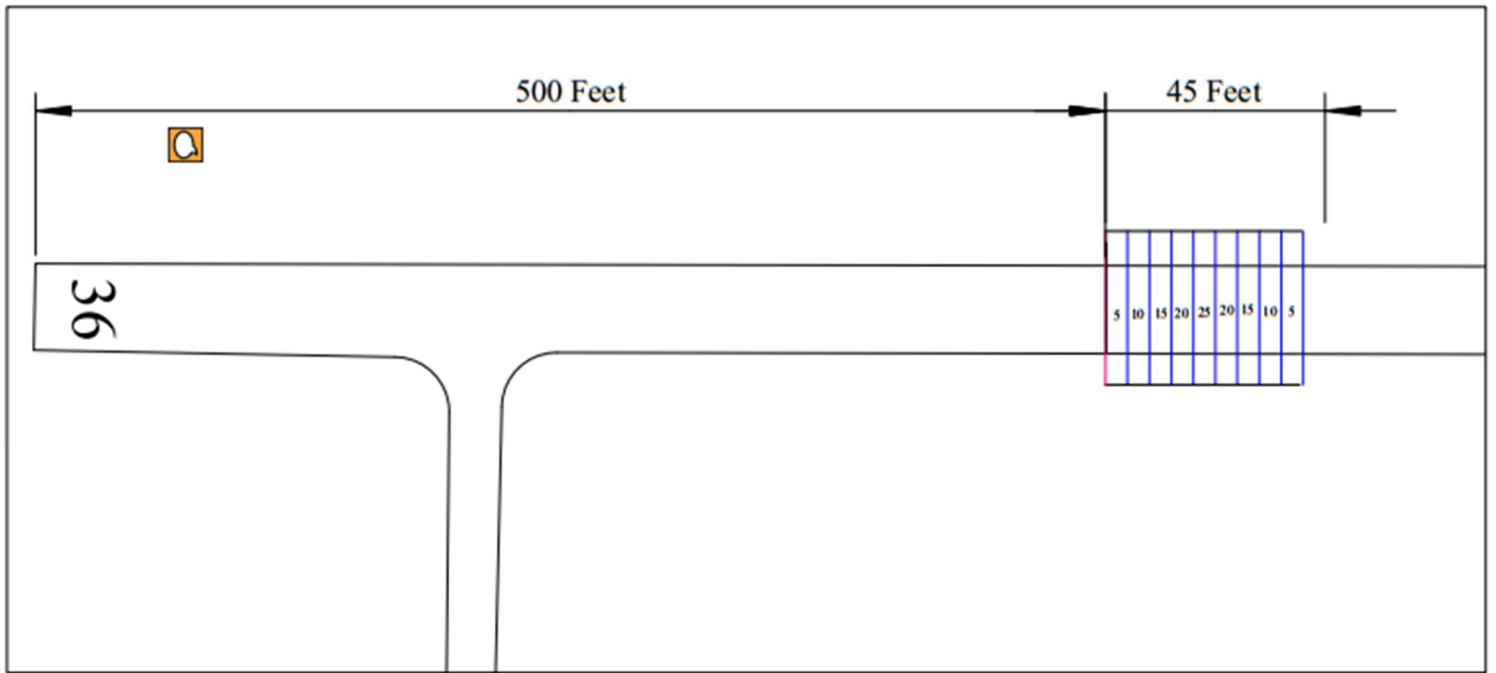


Power On Landing, RULES

1. Aircraft damaged during competition; void all points and disqualified.
2. Competitors shall have up to six attempts for the three-scored touchdowns.
3. If the competitor is not comfortable with the approach, they may go around.
4. Touchdown is when a main tire has touched the ground and rotated.
5. Awarded scores are for the first three actual touchdowns.
6. The three-scored points awarded and added together make for the total points awarded.
7. High points win.
8. Aircraft must be on the extended center line prior to crossing the runway end.
9. Aircraft must cross the runway end at least 100 feet AGL. (960 feet MSL).
10. Airspeed during this competition is at the competitor's discretion.
11. Throttle may be used during the descent and landing.
12. If there is a discussion regarding which box is landed in, then the next lower point box will be awarded.
13. Landing short or long of the target will receive 0 points.
14. Landing inside of one of the nine boxes shall receive:

First Box 5 points	Sixth Box, 20 points
Second box, 10 points	Seventh Box, 15 points
Third box, 15 points	Eight Box, 10 points
Forth box, 20 points	Ninth Box, 5 points
Fifth Box, 25 points
